

APPLE ROOTSTOCK - MALLING - 7

Apple Semi-Dwarf rootstock requires no support. Good resistance to collar rot and fire blight and adapts well to a wide range of soil types and climates. It has a tendency to sucker (Approximately 50-60% of Standard size)

PEAR - Pyrus Old Home x Farmingdale 97 PYRUS OHxF (HW)

Lexington, KY 40506

Hardwood cutting. Seedling vigor rootstock for fruiting pear. Has been proven to be more productive than Pyrus communis. Resistant to fire blight. Zone 4 - **(Standard size tree)**

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Broccoli and Beef Stir-Fry

Ingredients:

- 1 pound lean beef steak, sliced diagonally across the grain into thin strips
- 1 tablespoon plus ½ cup stir-fry sauce
- 1 clove minced garlic
- 4 tablespoons canola oil, divided
- 1 medium red onion, cut into ½ inch dice
- 1 sweet red pepper, cut into ½ inch dice
- 1 medium yellow squash, cut into ¼ inch slices
- 2 cups fresh broccoli florets
- 1 cup cauliflower florets
- 1/2 teaspoon crushed red pepper flakes

Directions:

Combine 1 tablespoon stir-fry sauce and minced garlic in a bowl. Add the beef strips. Let stand $\overline{15}$ minutes.

Heat 1 tablespoon canola oil in a large skillet or wok.

Add beef and stir fry for one minute. Remove beef from skillet.

Heat the remaining 3 tablespoons canola oil in the skillet or wok. Add vegetables. Stir-fry for four minutes or until vegetables are crisp-tender. Return beef to skillet.

Add the remaining ½ cup stir-fry sauce and red pepper flakes. Cook and stir 1 to 2 minutes longer, until heated through.



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
